

EMPATHY EXERCISE (7 min)

• We will now put ourselves in the shoes of our identified stakeholder group. We are going to go through a series of 5 questions individually and write down bullet point answers

- More research is needed to understand our identified stakeholder group, but just do the best you can for now.

• Put yourself in the shoes of our key stakeholder group...What qualities would make Two Oceans Foundation a reliable potential organization to partner with?

• What would incentivize you (as a key potential partnering organization to Two Oceans) to invest in Two Oceans' adult education program?

• On the other hand, what may hold you back from investing in Two Oceans' adult education program?

BUCKETING (10 min)


Categorizing ideas into buckets as a team

Use the **Strategic Impact Matrix** to analyze each of our own ideas.

- Impact includes but its not limited to Negative Impact and Gaps in Learning
- Ease includes but is not limited to Openness to Learn, Resources Required, and Gaps in Learning




FUNNEL ROUND 2 (10 min)
